OPmobility at VivaTech with IMPACT to showcase its technological innovations for road safety

OPmobility will be present for the first time at Viva Technology, the annual event dedicated to technological innovation and startups, to be held from June 11 to 14, 2025, at the Paris Expo Porte de Versailles, in Paris, France. On the stand of IMPACT, Association Antoine Alléno, the Group will be showcasing its technological innovations for road safety. A world leader in sustainable mobility and a technology partner to all mobility players worldwide, OPmobility joins the first coalition of players committed to fighting road violence.

OPmobility will showcase on the IMPACT stand its Digital Front Fascia, integrating a curved mini-LED display that turns the bumper into a visual and audio communication tool for improved road safety. The Digital Front Fascia is capable of signaling its presence and communicating with other road users by emitting audible messages or displaying safety messages on the front end of the vehicle.

Safety is at the heart of all the solutions developed by OPmobility, whether in exterior body parts, with bumpers that deform and absorb impact to protect pedestrians, lighting, with ADB headlamps that illuminate the road without dazzling other road users, or energy storage, with hydrogen systems designed to withstand high pressures. At VivaTech, the Group is taking a further step in its commitment by signing the Association Antoine Alléno's Charter of players committed to violence-free road mobility.

Founded in July 2022, the Association Antoine Alléno's mission is to protect young people under the age of 25 from all forms of road violence and to help them out. To achieve this, the association intends to act in three areas of general interest: supporting victims and families bereaved by road violence, raising public awareness and mobilizing to change laws and regulations and ensure that they are enforced.

Laurent Favre, Chief Executive Officer of OPmobility, said: *"Research and innovation enable the development of new technological solutions that make roads safer for pedestrians and all road users, especially the most vulnerable. By presenting breakthrough technologies for improving mobility safety at the IMPACT stand of the Association Antoine Alléno, of which the Group is a partner, OPmobility joins the first coalition of players committed to fighting road violence, offering concrete proposals for the future. The Group is thus reinforcing its role as a technological partner for all those involved in mobility, helping to make it safer and more sustainable."*
